The minimal font size for mobile per WCAG 2.0 standards. As such, I tried to keep most body text in the app to at least 18px. Texts below H4 only appear sparingly.

For example, H5 and H6 appear only in the pop-up modal when a project card is tapped on in the Timer page.

C1 and C2 only appear in the bottom navigation bar where there is limited space, and the icons are already explanatory.

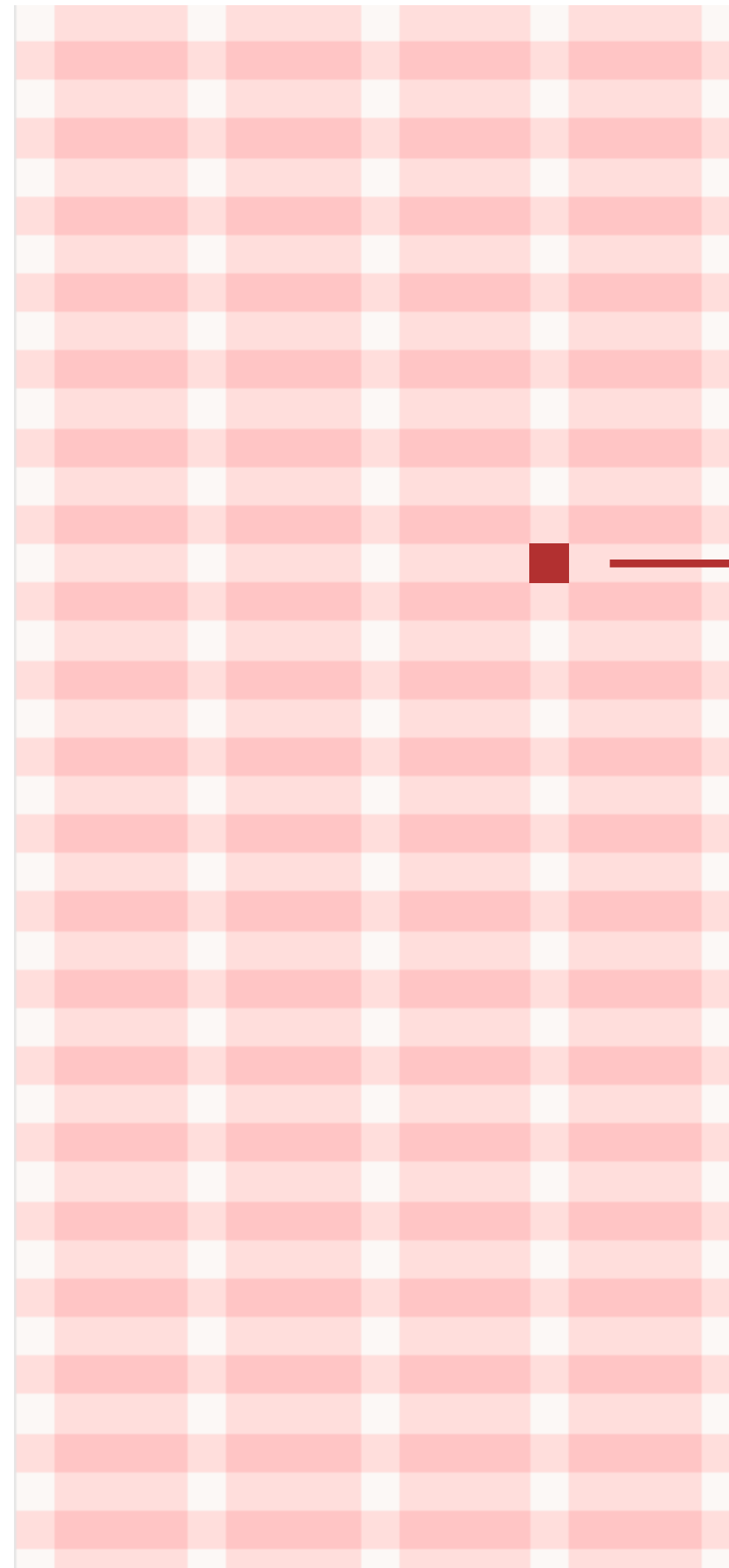
C3 only appears in the Export modal to explain the export options.

On another note, the serif font Unna (bold, 48px) is only used once in the wordmark.

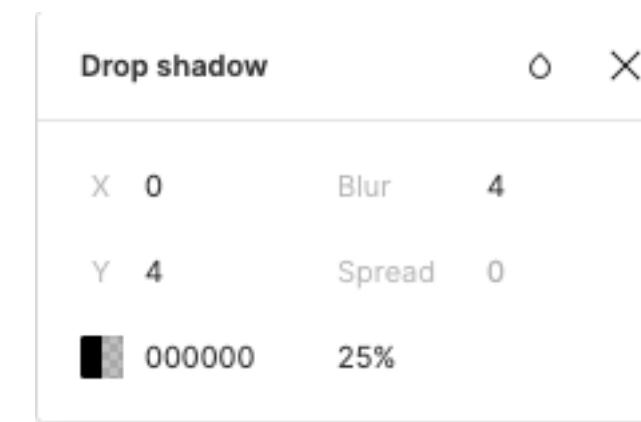
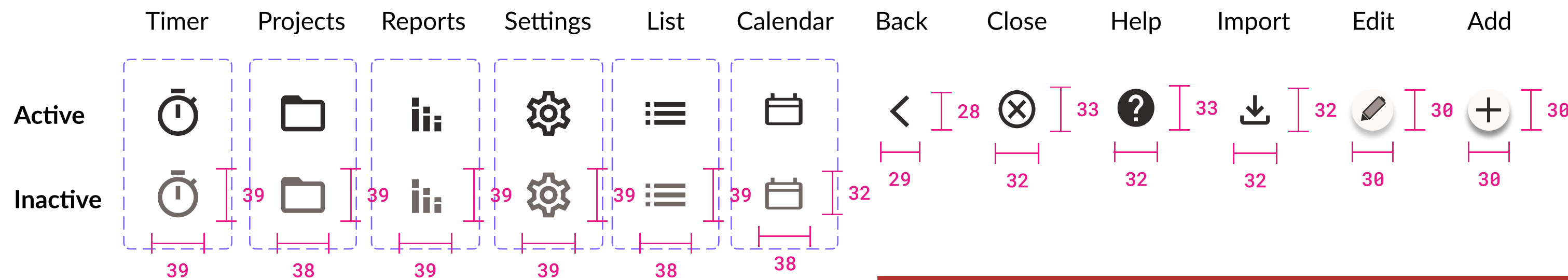


Thanks to this horizontal and vertical grid layout, I rarely had to use spacing blocks. However, for quick spacing comparisons, a block of 20px by 20px is used.

Icons & Buttons

These two icons appear on the Projects page and are the only two with more granular colours #2F2B2A (black), #9F908D (grey), and #FBF8F6 (very light beige). They also feature the drop shadow effect as seen in the screenshot.



These icons only have one state and would take the users to another page/modal upon being tapped.

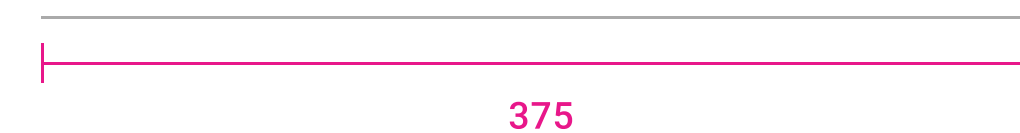
● Labels & Dividers

Icon labels only appear in the bottom navigation bar. Other icons are already self-explanatory.

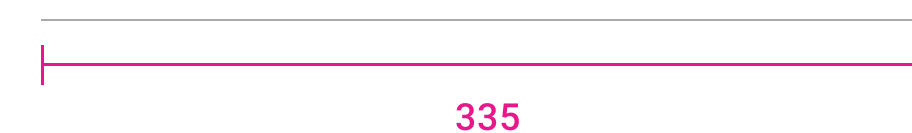
Icon label texts are C1 and C2

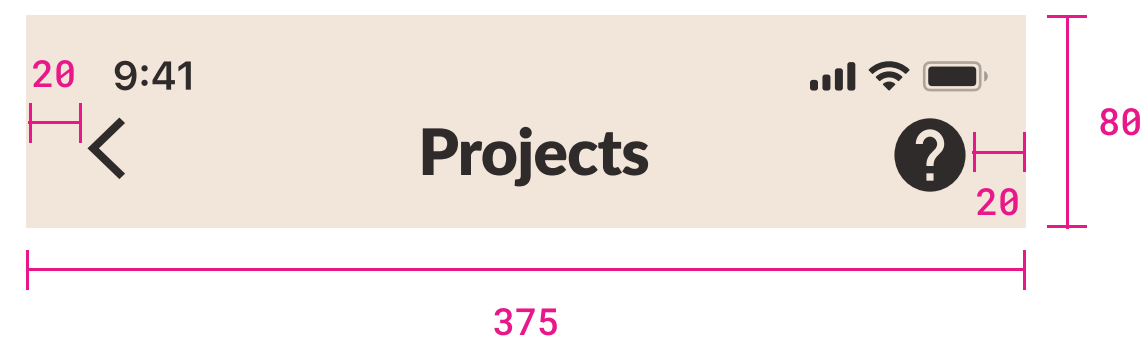
● Form Elements

Form input elements appear in the pages where users add a new project or a new category.

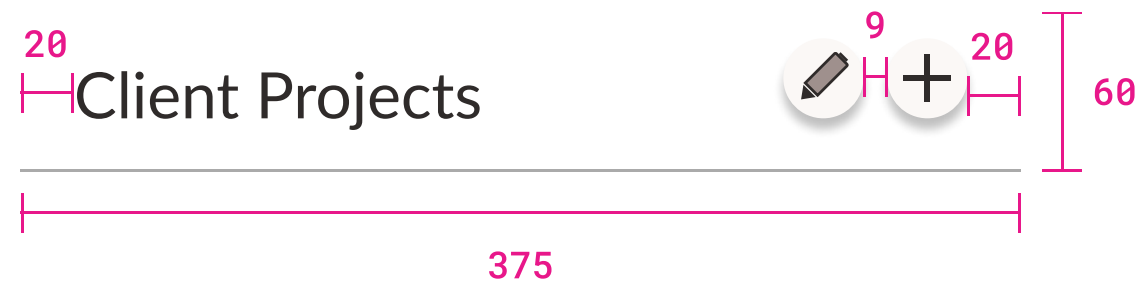

Dropdown		I haven't had time to develop the dropdown pop-up, but I imagine it will follow the standard iOS picker. This modal will pop up from the bottom of the screen and is not a native design in the app itself. As such, I believe the developers should be able to code the options for each appropriate form entry. The iOS standard picker passes the WCAG AA accessibility test.

Top Nav Bar: The top nav bar appears in the Projects and Reports pages.



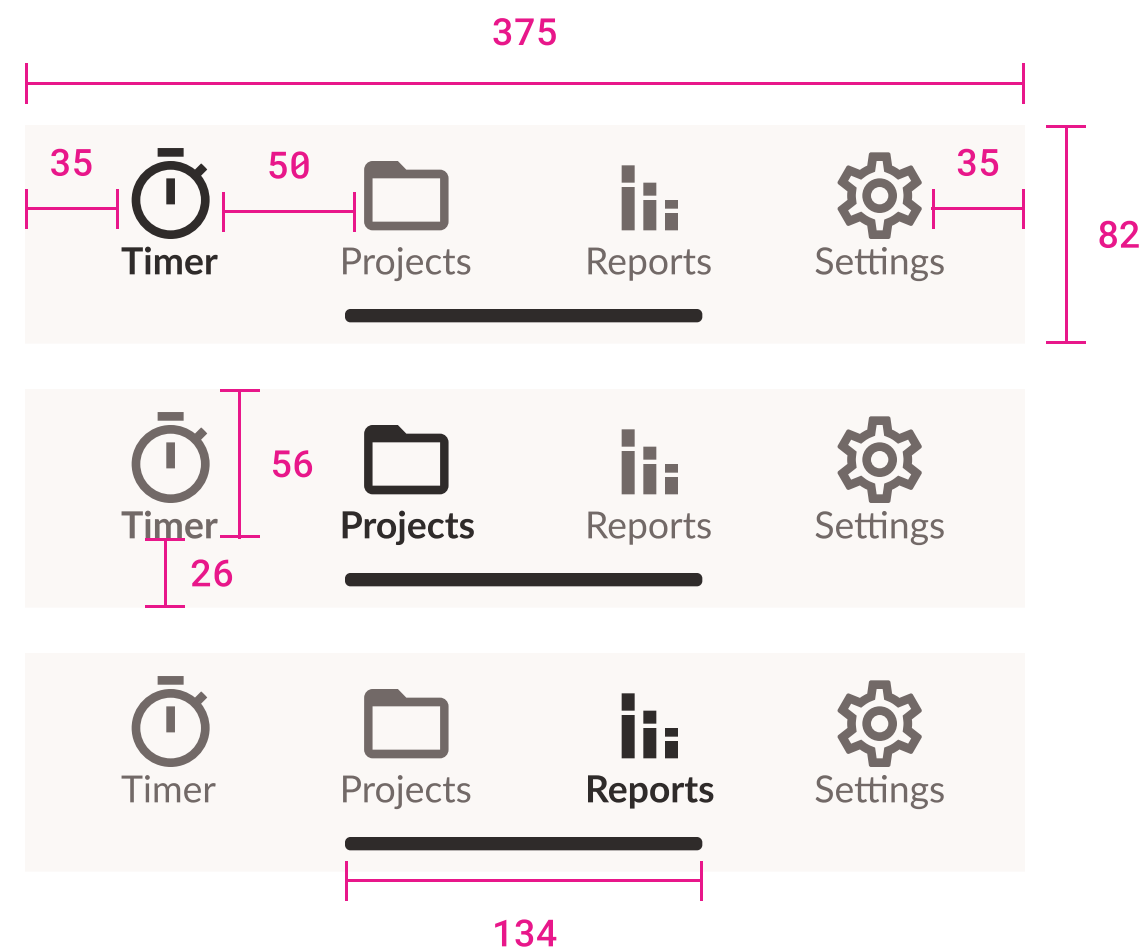
Project Bar: The project bars are stacked vertically in the Projects page.



Both bars use the same combination of colours from the atoms and pass WCAG AA.

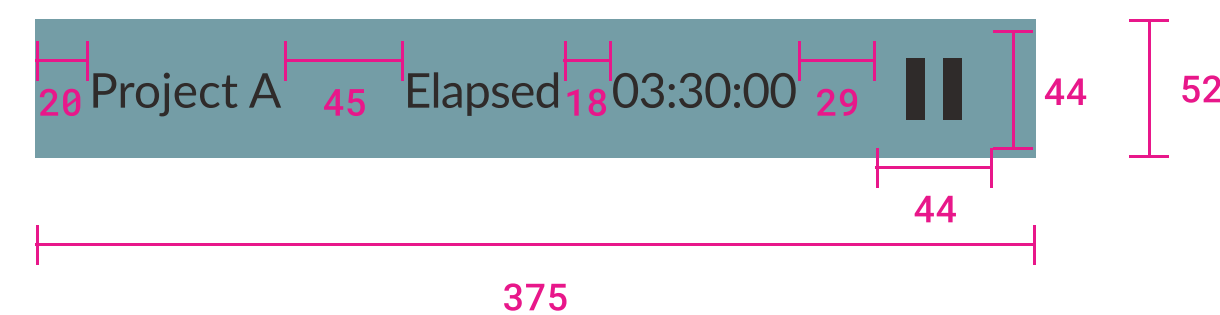

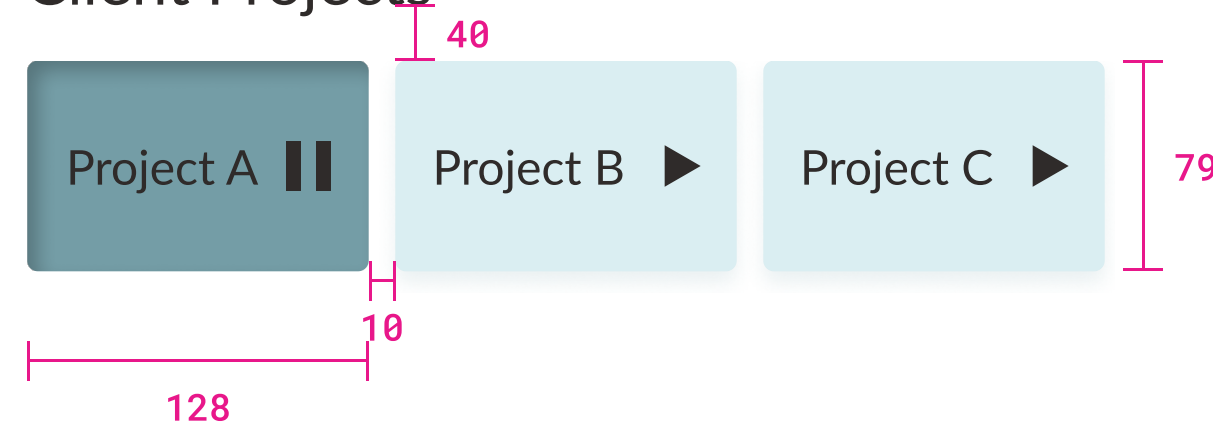


Progress bar also appears at the bottom of Timer and Project pages and right on top of the nav bar. This bar shows the current project selected on the Timer.

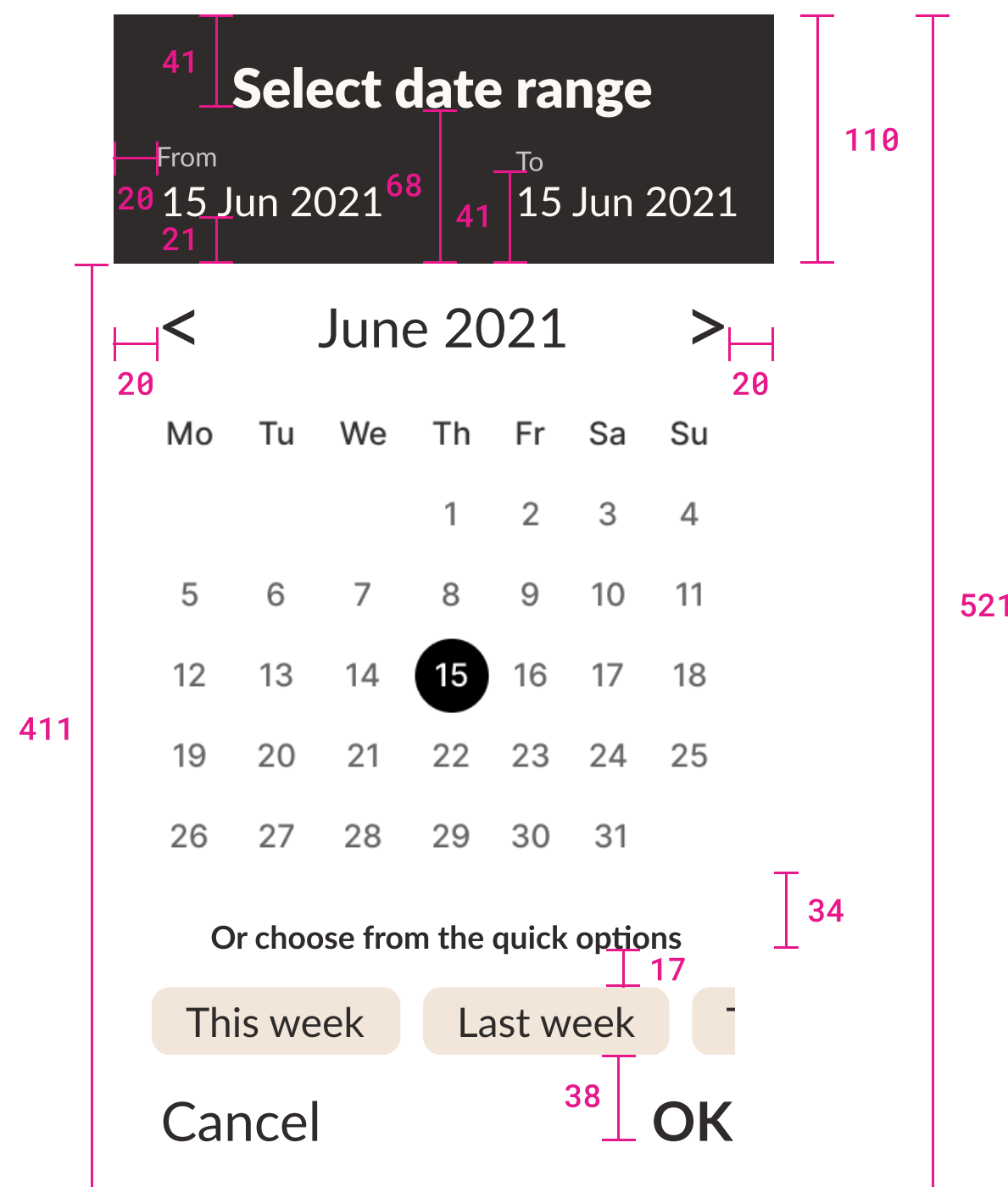

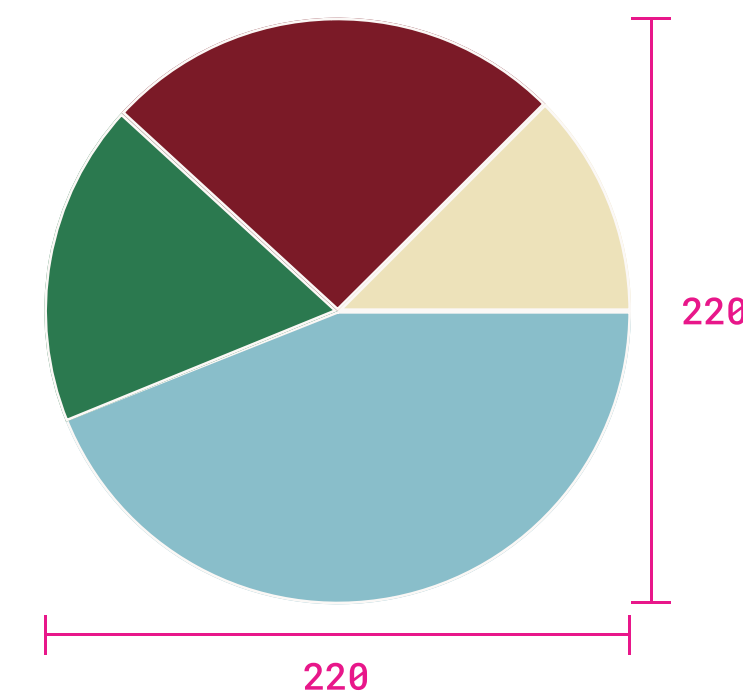
Horizontal-scrolling carousels are used for projects under the same category on the Timer page.

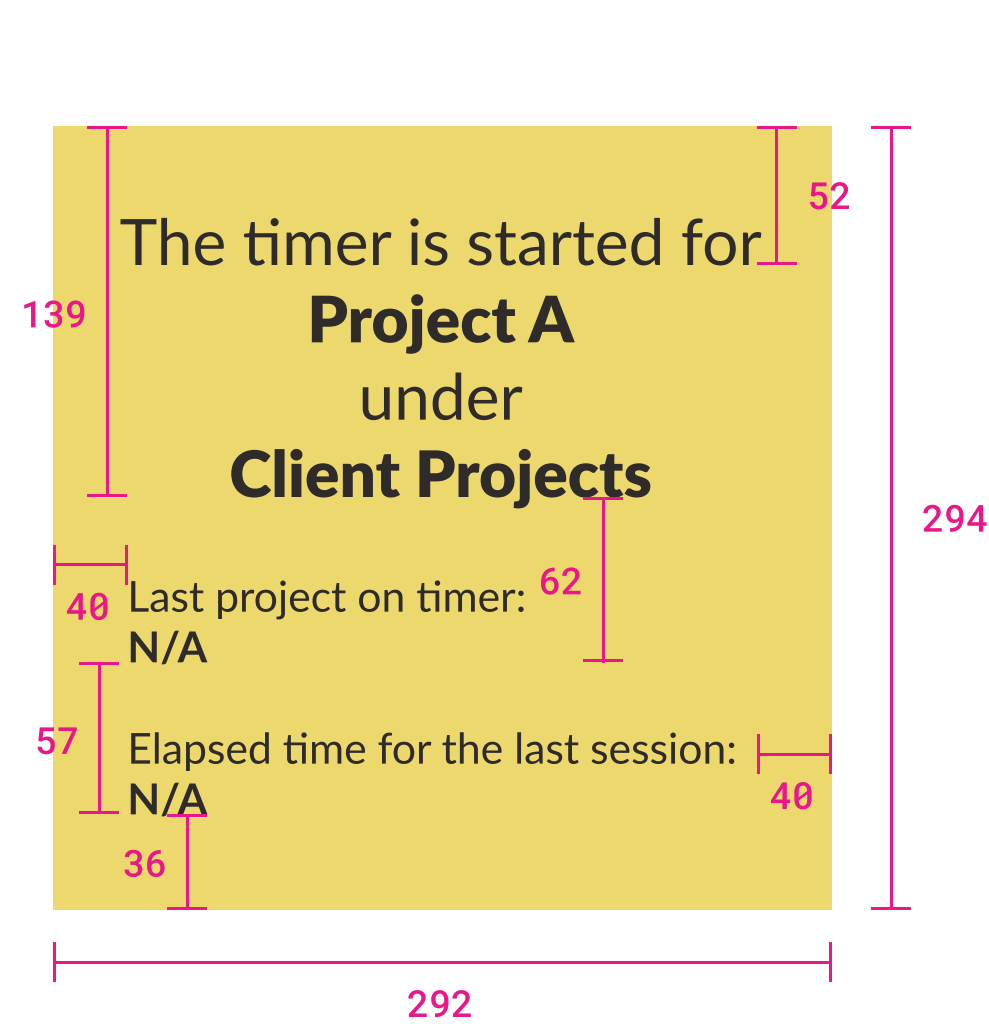
Date picker appears in the "Choose date" modal in the Reports page.

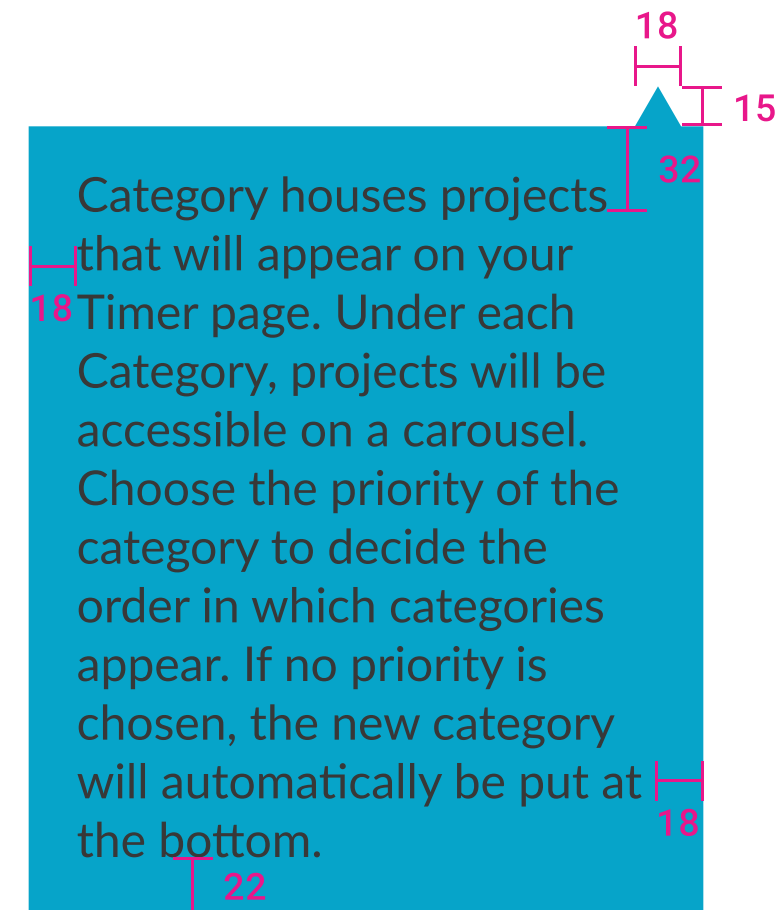


Pie chart appears in the Reports page under List View. Under the pie chart, each individual project along with the total time elapsed is listed.

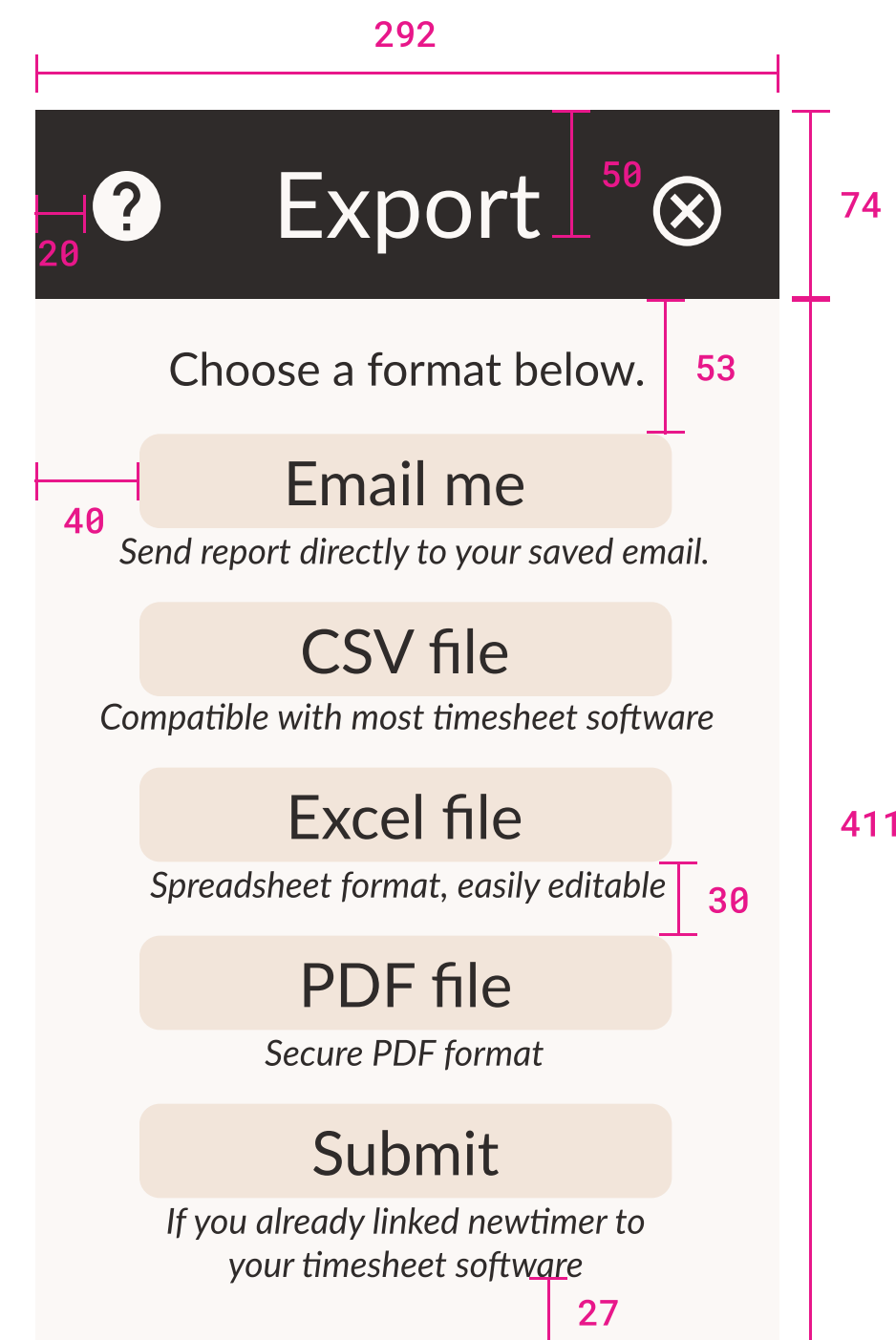

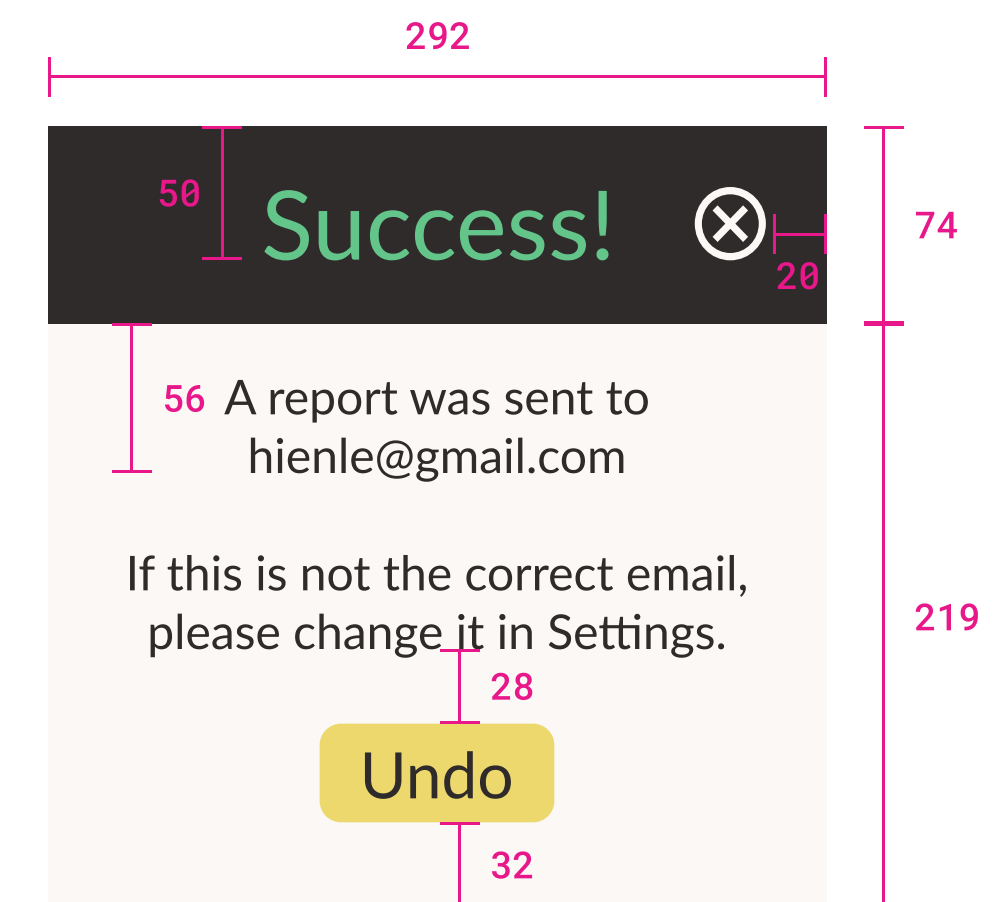
The timer modal appears for 4 seconds when a project button is pressed to warn the users of what they just selected.



The info modal appears when the users press on the Help icon on Add new project or Add new category as well as the List and Calendar icons on Reports.



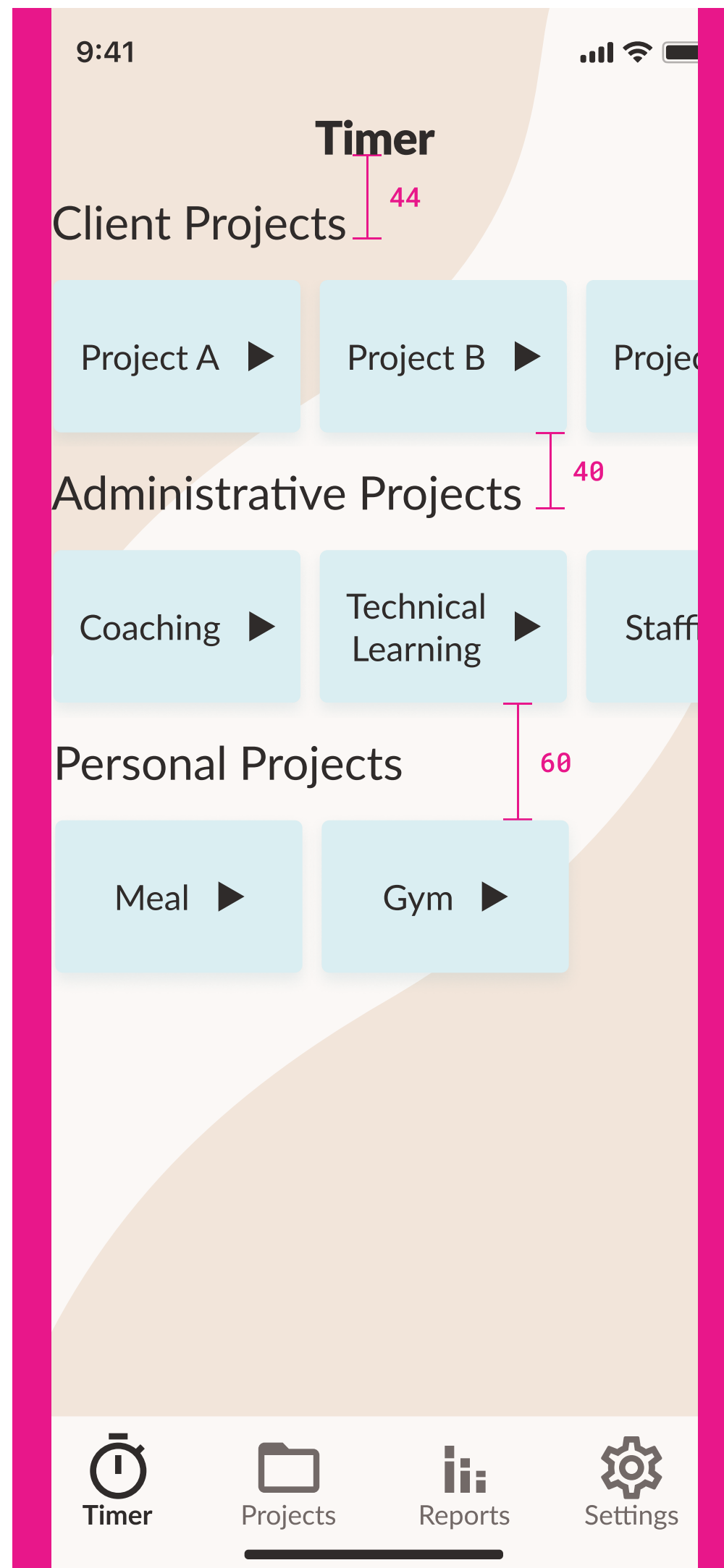
The export modal pops up when the users tap on the Export button on Reports page.



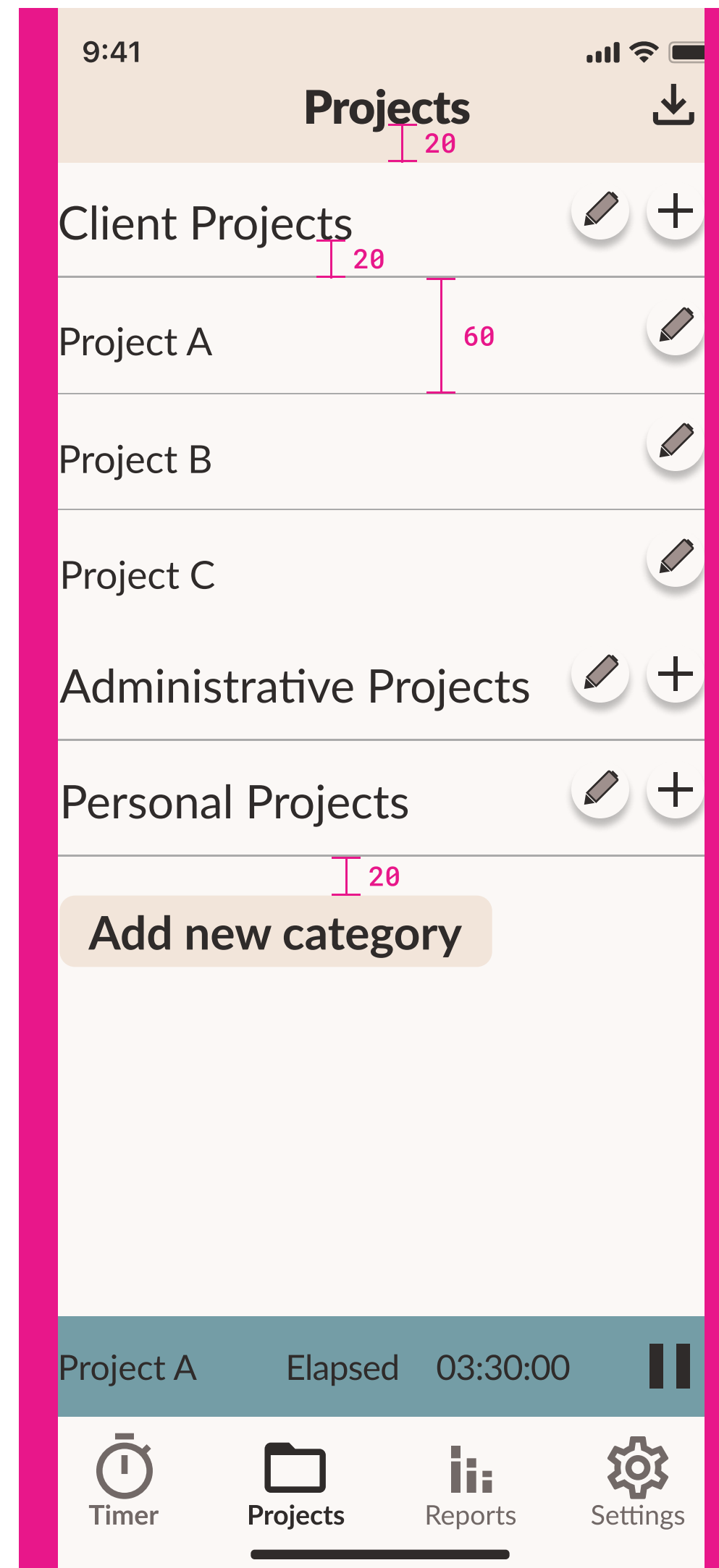
The success modal pops up after the timesheet is successfully exported.
